

Opportunities for Congregational Involvement

Give

Designate a Sunday as “Souper Bowl” Sunday and **take up an offering** to benefit EECM's Hunger Programs. All financial donations will be matched by an anonymous friend of EECM, up to \$30,000.

Collect

Organize a **congregation-wide food drive**. We can design a flier to attach to grocery bags to distribute to your congregation. Food Drives can also be a great project for Sunday school classes, Bible studies, and small groups. Assign each group a different food, or hold a competition to see who can collect the most items.
